Karel "Wollie" Wolmarans

Senior Professor Dr. Karel "Wollie" Wolmarans is a South African martial artist, academic, and health practitioner. He is known for his extensive contributions to traditional and modern martial arts across Africa, as well as for his academic work in complementary and alternative health sciences. Wolmarans holds multiple senior ranks in various martial arts systems and is the founder and chief instructor of several African martial arts organizations.

Early life and martial arts beginnings

Wolmarans began his martial arts training at the age of five, studying **Karate**, **Aikido**, **Jujitsu**, **Goshin-jitsu**, **Judo**, **Kubu-do**, **Atemi all under Shihan Ronnie Sin Hidge Sensei 6th Dan**, **Shihan Neil Scheepers Sensei 6th Dan**, **Shihan Des Westernburg Sensei 6th Dan** and under Sensei Johnny Gouws 6th Dan, Sensei Jan Calitz 6th Dan senior students of **Prof. Jack Robinson 10th Dan (Undefeated World Judo Champion)** as his foundational disciplines. Over the decades, he expanded his studies to encompass a wide range of traditional and modern martial arts, achieving senior master ranks in several styles.

Shihan Dr. Karel "Wollie" Wolmarans Sensei was promoted to 10th Dan by Shihan Reynosa Rashihsho Sensei 10th Dan. Wollie also travelled and trained in Japan, where he trained in Karate, Aikido, Ju-jitsu, Judo, Kubu-do, Kubu-jitsu and also trained under Soke Gozo Shioda 10th Dan.
